The following amendments to the Class Rules have been approved by the class rules sub committee to be effective 8th June 2009.

Rule 9.4 – Sail Measurement Grandfathering

New Rule: Insert rule as below and renumber accordingly.

4. Rule 9.3 shall only apply to boats that were fundamentally measured for the purpose of certification control prior to 1st January 2005, all other boats shall only carry sails that comply with rule 9.2.

Rule 9.10 – Sail Setting

Amendment:

Where the sail is set up on spars, no part of the sail luff shall extend beyond the lower edge of the upper mast band, or below the upper edge of the lower mast band except as provided for in rule 9.4.

Rule 12 – RRS Alterations

New Rule:

12. Alterations to the Racing Rules of Sailing

12.1 RRS 42.3(c) is amended to read:

When surfing (rapidly accelerating down a wave) or foiling (sailing with the hull clear of the water due to the effect of hydrofoils) or planing is possible, the boat's crew may pull the sheet in order to initiate surfing, foiling or planing, but only twice for each wave or gust of wind or just after having completed a tack or a gybe.
